

REMARKS.

1. These several sums of \$2,681.00, \$138.00 and \$1,130.25, amounting to \$4,249.25, were for extra services of persons receiving regular payment in the Department for which the extra work was done. The payments were made in opposition to sec. 20, of 31st Vic., cap. 34.

2. During the early part of the year, Mr. Tims received a living allowance, while travelling, at the rate of five dollars per day; but attention was called to the Order in Council fixing the maximum rate at three and a half dollars per day, and the accounts for the remaining portion of the year were rendered in accordance with the regulation.

3. Mr. Crookshank, during the latter part of the year, received a living allowance, while travelling, at the rate of two and one-half dollars per day, and earlier, his actual expenses as well as a bonus of two and one-half dollars per day
