

An Act further to amend the Acts respecting the  
North-West Territories.

**H**ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as  
follows:—

- 1.** Subsection 1 of section 14 of *The North-West Territories Act*, chapter 50 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words "Lieutenant Governor in Council" and substituting therefor the words "Legislative Assembly." R.S.C., c. 50.

- 2.** Subsection 2 of the said section 14 is hereby repealed. Further amended.
- 3.** Section 49 of the said Act is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:— New section 49.
- "**49.** The court shall sit in banc at such times and places as the Lieutenant Governor in Council appoints; the senior judge present shall preside, and three judges of the court shall constitute a quorum." Sittings of Supreme Court.
- 4.** The section substituted for section 18 of chapter 17 of the statutes of 1894, by section 9 of chapter 28 of the statutes of 1897 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "employment" in the second line thereof the words "under the Government of the Territories." 1894, c. 17.
