An Act to prevent the traffic in Alcoholic and Intoxicating Liquors.

THEREAS the common traffic in intoxicating Liquors and their Preamble. vuse as a beverage is a fruitful cause of crime, poverty, disease and demoralization; And whereas it is the first duty of Government to protect the people against these evils: Be it therefore enacted, &c., that

5 From and after the time limited for the commencement of this Act, it shall General rule not be lawful for any person or persons to manufacture, barter or sell, direct- laid down. ly or indirectly, to any other person any alcoholic or intoxicating Liquor or any mixed Liquor a part of which is alcoholic or intoxicating (and every such mixed liquor shall be included in the expression "alcoholic or in-10 toxicating liquor" when used in this Act), except for medicinal, che-

mical or mechanical purposes as hereinafter provided.

II. Any person not being a licensed manufacturer or an agent duly Penalty for appointed under the provisions of this Act, who shall, by himself, his contravening clerk servant or agent manufacture expects or leave for factors for the General clerk, servant or agent, manufacture, expose or keep for safe or barter, rule aforesaid.

- 15 or shall sell, dispose or exchange for any other matter or thing, to any other person any alcoholic or intoxicating Liquor, except according to the provisions of this Act, shall be liable to a fine of  $\mathcal{L}$ on the first conviction, £ on the second, and on the third and every subsequent conviction to such last mentioned fine and imprisonment for a
- 20 period not more than six calendar months, such fine to be paid over to the Chamberlain, Treasurer, Clerk, or Secretary-Treasurer, of the Municipality in which the offence shall be proved to have been committed, for the use of the Municipality, and to be applied to such public purposes as the Council thereof may direct; and in default of payment of any
- 25 fine imposed under this Act, with the costs of prosecution, at the time of conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned until the same be paid : Provided that nothing contained in this Act shall be construed to prevent Proviso. any Chemist, Artist or Manufacturer, in whose art or trade they may be necessary, from keeping at his place of business such reasonable and 30 proper quantity of distilled liquors as he may have occasion to use in
- his art or trade, but not for sale or barter.

III. If any clerk, servant or agent, or other person in the employment Agent liable or on the premises of another, shall sell or manufacture, or assist in sell- equally with ing or manufacturing, any alcoholic or intoxicating Liquor, (except un-principal.

35 der the provisions of this Act) for the person in whose service or on whose premises he may be, he shall be held equally guilty with the principal, and shall suffer the like penalty.
