

An Act to extend the powers of the Toronto and Nipissing Railway Company.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Legislature of the Province of Ontario, passed in the Thirty-first year of Her Majesty's reign, chaptered Forty-one, intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Toronto and Nipissing Railway Company," certain persons therein named, with all such other persons or corporations as should become shareholders in such Company as was therein mentioned, were constituted and declared to be a body corporate and politic, in fact, by and under the name and style of the Toronto and Nipissing Railway Company.

10. And whereas the said Company have petitioned and prayed that an Act may be passed to amend their charter by giving them power to extend their said line of railway from Lake Nipissing northward, through the lands of the Dominion to James' Bay, and it is expedient to grant their prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by
15 and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. All the corporate powers, rights, and privileges, vested in the Toronto and Nipissing Railway Company, by virtue of the Act of the Province of Ontario passed in the Thirty-first year of Her Majesty's reign, chaptered Forty-one, intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Toronto and Nipissing Railway Company" are continued by this Act, and may be exercised as fully and effectually as if specially set out herein.

2. The said Company and their servants and agents shall have full power under this Act, to extend the line of their said railway from any point on Lake Nipissing as they may determine upon, to some point on James' Bay, with full power to carry the said railway through the Crown Lands lying between the same.

3. The said Company shall further have power to purchase, build, fit out, and charter, sell and dispose of, work and control, and keep in repair, steam or other vessels, from time to time, to ply on Lake Nipissing and James' Bay, and also to make arrangements and agreements with steamboat proprietors, by chartering or otherwise, on these waters.

4. The said extension shall be commenced within five years, and be completed in ten years from the passing of this Act.
