

six calendar months next after the fact upon which the same is grounded, shall have been committed.

Exception,

XIII. Provided always, and be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that nothing in this Act contained, shall extend to the Members of His Majesty's Legislative Council, or to the Members of His Majesty's Executive Council, or to the Justices of the Courts of King's Bench, or Provincial Judges, or to His Majesty's Attorney-General for the time being.

XIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that no manner of person or persons having, using or exercising the office of Sheriff, or Coroner, in or for any District in this Province, shall be able or qualified to be a Justice of the Peace in any District where he or they shall be Sheriff or Coroner, during the time that he or they shall have, use or exercise the said office of Sheriff or Coroner ; and that all and every act and acts to be done by any such Sheriff or Sheriffs, Coroner or Coroners, by authority of any Commission of the Peace, during the time aforesaid, shall be absolutely void and of none effect.
