

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Merchants' Bank of Halifax.

**W**HEREAS, in and by the Act to incorporate the Merchants' Bank of Halifax, it is provided that the unpaid stock shall be called in at such time as shall be prescribed by future legislation, and application has been made to enable the said Corporation to call in and add to the paid up capital the further sum of \$100,000; therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The Directors of the Merchants' Bank of Halifax may, and they are hereby authorized to call in and require the payment of the further sum of one hundred thousand dollars of the capital stock of the Corporation, in addition to a sum of three hundred thousand dollars authorized and directed to be called in and paid up in and by the Act hereby amended; but the same shall not be called in until thirty days' notice shall have been first given, in at least two of the newspapers published in Halifax, of the time and place appointed for the payment thereof.
