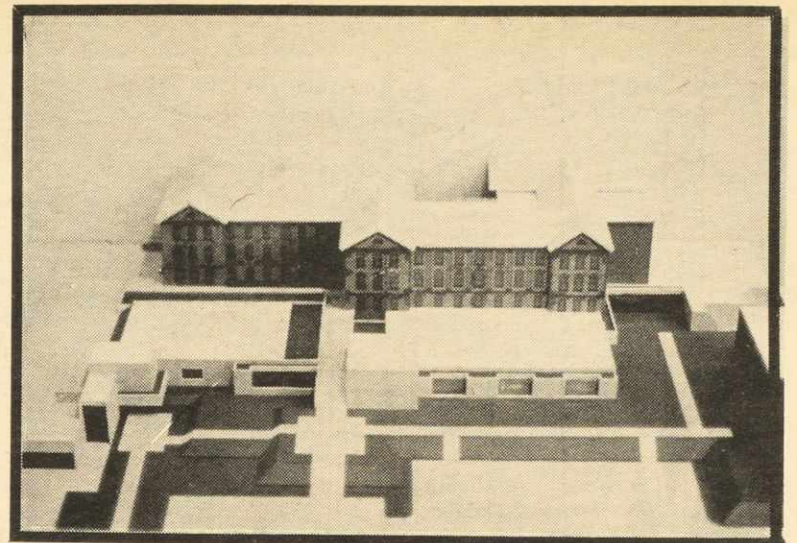
phases have not yet been finalized, says Shaw.

Shaw says the project will cost about \$10 million over a five year period. He says about \$7.5

million will come from the provincial government's university assistance act and about \$2.5 million will come from the capital fund drive, \$1 million of which was donated by the Windsor foundation.

The new facility will be located adjacent to the existing building

on what is now a parking lot, taking up about 100 parking spaces. Jim Sykes, director of planning and development for Dal says "we have an obligation to provide 1730 parking spaces and we will meet that commitment. Just where hasn't been decided yet".

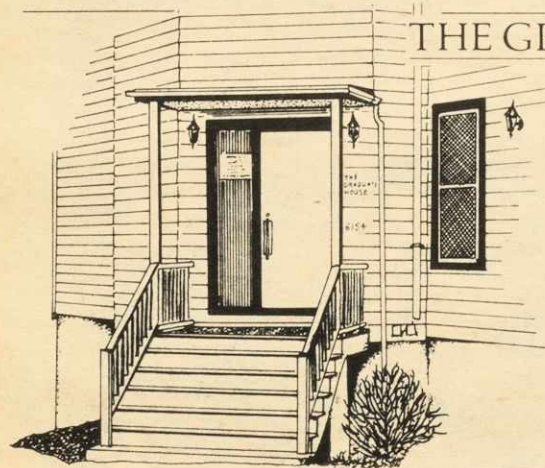
