



Ottawa, September 10th., 1917.

Rev. Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 25th August, enclosing account for drugs supplied since Nov. 1916 amounting to \$47.97, and to inform you that there was an error of .30 cents in the addition, making the total \$47.77. A portion of this amount, namely for drugs supplied up to the 31st March last should have been paid from the appropriation of last fiscal year which terminates on the 31st March. I have therefore to request that in future you will forward these accounts at least quarterly to the Department.
