We beg to make appilcation to you and through our Indian Agent for a holding of land which we have held from our forefathers for generations past, and now that settlers are coming into the country we fear that it will be encroached upon and taken up so we appeal to you to empower the Indian Agent Mr. W.E.Collison to secure it to us. We applied to Mr. C.C.Perry for it some 20 years ago and he promised to secure it for us and instructed us to erect the posts which we did but as they had decayed we have just renewed them and made out a sketch plan of the site with notes, and by that you will instruct the Indian Agent W.E.Collison Esq. to secure it for us and our families, and we your petitioners will ever pray.
