

at one previous exhibition and has two works at the current exhibition.

In the case of the election of an artist of reputation or the re-instalment of an old member, the rule regarding exhibiting shall be set aside.

New members are to be elected by ballot, a two-thirds majority of votes cast shall elect.

ARTICLE VI.

The annual fee for members shall be ten dollars, due on the first day of January in each year. Members shall farther be responsible for any additional sum that may be considered necessary for the management of the Society. Any levy of money for this purpose must be by notice of motion to that effect made by the Executive Council and approved by a two-thirds majority of the members present at a subsequent special meeting of the Society called for that purpose. The Secretary to give written notice to all members of such notice of motion within the space of one week after such notice is given.

**Fees and
Liabilities.**

Any member whose fees are two years in arrears, or who has failed to submit pictures for the Annual Exhibition for two successive years, shall cease to be a member and his name shall be taken off the roll.
