

The Pasteurization of Milk Saves Thousands of the Little Lives.

The count of ordinary bulk milk runs from 20,000—50,000 to the cubic centimeter; that is, 15 drops of milk. Certified Milk runs from 400 to 2,000 per C.C. In Pasteurized Milk from the Hospital plant, the count is zero. The Hospital pasteurizes Certified Milk only.



Babies Fed on Hospital Formulas.

These little ones were thin and emaciated when they commenced taking formulas. Just look at them now.

The Hospital plant is the same as the celebrated plant of Nathan Strauss in New York. In that plant last summer a report shows that out of 2,265 babies using pasteurized milk, only one died—and that one from pneumonia.
