

The letters W. S. standing for West side; S. S., South side; E. S., East side; N. S., North side; as also where the word "off" occurs, indicating the house inhabited by that party is built off the street; and in like manner, the word "rear" that the only entrance to it is behind that occupied by the preceding name.

The line, "here Church-street intersects," as in the case of Alexander, means that the houses on Alexander-street are divided by Church street running across.

In all cases where obtained, many unwillingly, others refusing altogether, the names of boarders or others lodging in the various houses are given, and two or more names coupled together in a bracket signify that the second and following names are only occupying part of the premises, the first name being the actual householder. In two or three instances, streets are more generally known by other names than those appertaining on the Survey; to prevent confusion, they are given under the best known name.
