Good agricultural horses being \$150 to \$220 and fair quality ones, \$100 to \$150. Express horses are quoted \$170 to \$260. Drivers \$150 to \$250 and saddlers \$160 to \$265.

LIVE STOCK
A week ago today cattle were a little stronger than on the Monday previous, port cattle ruling the higher all around. Export prices brought \$5.50 to \$6 with \$5.10 for the top price. The offering also was larger than the week previous but receipts were nevertheless, small. Prices were maintained through the week on small supplies. From the drover's point of view a pleasing feature of the market is the active demand on local markets that kept the price of butcher cattle almost on the level with choice export stock.

The maintenance of prices, however, for small shipments. Leading dealers have expressed this opinion that few large shipments this coming week would break the market. So they have shown discretion in the marketing of their stock. It is expected that business will open up prices for export cattle will improve. An unusual feature of the market is the small quantity of cattle that are being shipped west to small supplies of feed last week the west was practically drained of cattle. With plenty of feed on hand the Ontario farmer will be well advised to report a loss on butchering his finished stock. Quotations at the close of the week were as follow: Choice export cattle, \$5 to \$6.10; butcher cattle, choice, \$5.60 to \$6.25; medium, \$4.75 to \$5.65; butcher cows, choice, \$4.75 to \$5.25; moon, \$3 to \$4.75; canners \$2.25 to \$2.75. The market for hogs is anything but firm and further decline of five cents is reported. Hogs to be shipping points are \$5.25 and \$5.90 on the market. Montreal live stock markets are easier and drovers are having difficulty in disposing of their offerings. At the close of the week rates were as follows: Choice, \$3.25 to \$5.25; and bulls, \$4 to \$5.25. Demand for calves was fairly good with large supplies and prices ruling low at from \$2 to \$6 each. In sheep and lambs the quence was small and trade in consequence was slow. Sheep sold at \$4.75 to \$5 and lambs at \$5 to \$7 each.

MONTREAL HOG MARKET
Montreal, Saturday April 1—Prices current here this week for live hogs were practically unchanged from last week, though the general market is easier owing to the heavy supplies offering all good demand however and every thing offered was sold at \$7.20 to \$7.40 a cwt., for selected and every other carcass. There was a good trade in dressed hogs, to \$10.00 a cwt., and country dressed at \$2.25 to \$2.25 a cwt.

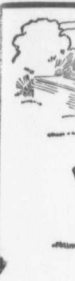
