their towns upon the river Au Beuf; and if boys of fifteen and fixteen are allowed to be of the military age, I faw in that town alone more than an hundred Penfilvanian children, every individual of whom was so totally savagized, (if I may fay fo) that we could not extract a syllable of English from them. When we reflect on the horrible ravages these two nations (so trifling in their numbers) have committed in our colonies, we may, I think, form a proper idea of the dreadful light an Indian war ought to be confidered in, how irrefistible they are in their attacks, how fecure from being attacked. Virginia, Maryland, Penfylvania and part of Jersey, from the Blue Mountains above one hundred miles in breadth and more than fix hundred miles from north east to south west, one of the richest
