

Provincial Parliament.

LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY.

QUEBEC, 3rd November.

Last night a new writ was issued for St. Lawrence.

Mr. Hincks in Committee carried a resolution to the following effect:—"That it is expedient to repeal so much of the Railroad Guarantee Act, 12th Victoria, chap. 29th, as relates to the aid proposed to be given to the proposed Railroad between Quebec and Halifax; and instead thereof to provide that the guarantee of the Province may be given to any Company which shall be formed for the construction of the Railroad from Quebec to Trois Pistoles."

That it is expedient to provide for the incorporation of a Company to construct the said Railroad, whenever a sufficient number of persons shall express their willingness to construct the same. That it is expedient to provide that if such Company shall extend the said road from Trois Pistoles to the eastern limits of the Province, a tract of 1,000,000 acres may be granted to the Company, and a bill to incorporate such a Company. Also, a bill to enable the several Railroad Companies forming the Main Trunk Line, to join and form one Company.

The Bill to increase the Stock of the Montreal Bank, was read a third time, and the following amendment had been carried, on motion of Hon. Mr. Hincks, by adding the following names in the 34th line of the first clause: Alexander Tulloch Galt, of town of Sherbrooke, Esq.; Luther Hamilton, Esq.; and David Lewis McLellan, Esq. of the City of Montreal, Esquires.

The following amendment lost, viz:—"Mr. Brown."—That the bill be referred to a Select Committee to enquire whether the interests of the public will not be better promoted by accepting the offer of the Her Majesty's Secretary for the Colonies of an Imperial Loan for the construction of the Great Railroad.

Mr. Gamble.—That the bill be amended by adding the words at the end of the 4th clause "provided always, that nothing in this act shall extend or be construed to extend to authorize the Committee to issue certificates for stock, for any greater amount than shall actually be expended in constructing the said railroad."

A motion by Mr. McKinnon, for the House to go into Committee on the property of addressing Her Majesty to repeal the clause in the Union act requiring a vote of two thirds to change the constitution of the House of Assembly—was lost, only three voting for the motion.

On the adjournment of the House, the adjournment of the 14th February next, and the debate was progressing as the report left. The Ministry rather lean to adjournment.

QUEBEC, Nov. 4, 1852.

Last Night after the dispatch left, the adjournment of the House from this day week, to the 14th February, was carried by a majority of 37 to 35. The Governor General, sent down a message recommending the granting a pension of £200 per annum to the Widow of the late Col. Anthon.

The following Bills were passed through Committee, Great Western Railroad Extension, Galt and Guelph Railway, McGill College, Montreal University, Coloung and Peterborough Railway, and the resolutions respecting the Montreal Harbour, which were agreed to in Committee, on the 10th ult., and those respecting the erection of a Cathedral Church at Three Rivers, were reported and concurred in, in the latter on the division—20 to 14, namely Brown, Mallot, Marchion, and Patrick. During the debate on the adjournment, Mr. Carriere expressed his hope that the commercial policy of the country would be decided by the House, and that Mr. Hincks did not know that anything could be done immediately, inasmuch as the action of the Canadian Government must depend upon the course of legislation upon the other side of the line, besides it was not the intention to introduce any measure which would take effect before the April quarter and again it was not intended that the differential duties should apply in any way to goods imported into Canada from Great Britain. Orders for British goods, might be sent as usual. Mr. McKinnon moved, that the House, to-morrow, go into Committee on the propriety of raising an address to Her Majesty, praying for the pardon of Smith O'Brien and his Irish associates.—The motion was opposed by Messrs. Hincks and Drummond, as calculated to do more harm than good to the exiles. The motion was at length lost.

QUEBEC, 5th November.

Last night the following bills were read a third time and passed:—

For incorporating the Halifax College, Hamilton and Guelph Railroad, and McGill College.

Coloung and Peterboro' Railroad, with an amendment adding the words "to give the government power to prevent the bridging of Rice Lake."

In Committee, a resolution was passed extending the 18th sec. of the Railroad clause of the Consolidated Act, to the Peterboro' and Port Hope Railroad.

The Toronto and Guelph Railroad Bill passed through Committee on division—Sir A. MacNab opposing it.

The Bradford and Buffalo Railroad bill also passed through Committee.

This morning, the following resolutions were passed in Committee of the Whole on the motion of Mr. Chabot:—1st. That it was expedient to establish a line of steam screw vessels to run between the ports of Liverpool and Quebec and Montreal in this Province, once in every fortnight during the navigation of the River St. Lawrence and between the said port of Liverpool and Halifax in Nova Scotia, and Portland in the United States of America, once in every month in the winter season.

2. That it was expedient to appropriate a sum not exceeding £19,000 sterling per annum, for seven years, commencing on the first day next, to carry the above resolution into execution.

3. That it is expedient that the said steam-vessels should be exempted from the payment of all light dues, or any other imposts on the River St. Lawrence.

The Bill to provide for the change of the Registry Office of Missisquoi, was read a first time, and the House having gone into Committee of the Whole, on motion of Mr. Hincks, passed a resolution declaring that it was expedient to grant a pension of £200 a year to the widow of the late Col. Anthon. A division was taken which will not be reported till the motion for concurrence of the House is taken.

The ministerial proposition was that the pension should be for life, but upon amendment of Mr. Christie (Gaspé), Mr. Hincks consented in deference to the opinion manifested in the House, that it should be granted only from year to year.

The Bill for the more equal distribution of business in the Courts of Upper Canada was read a first time.

The Montreal Loan Bill and Kingston Loan Bill were read a third time. This afternoon the Raoudon and Industry amendment bill was read a first time.

Also, the bill to transfer certain property to the Bishop of St. Hyacinthe. Also St. Hyacinthe Incorporation Act. The Montreal Manufacturers' Company Bill was read a third time and passed on a division—Mr. Brown opposing it on the ground that it contains a clause granting unlimited liability.

The British America Life Assurance Company's Bill was read a third time.

Also, the St. Mary's College Incorporation Bill, after a sharp debate between Messrs. Hincks and Drummond, on one side, who alleged that their vote against the Bill was only intended to make it await the general measure; and Messrs. Cauchon and Sicotte who held that they ought not to have voted against it.
