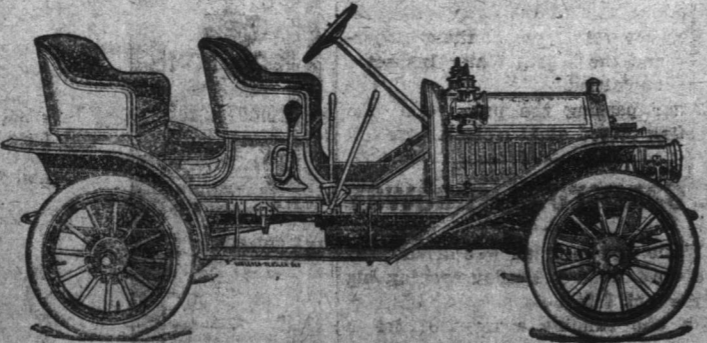

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE ELECTORS within the MUNICIPAL limits of the TOWN OF ST. JOHN'S aforesaid that in obedience to HIS MAJESTY'S WRIT to me directed and bearing date the 8th day of June, 1910, I require the presence of the said Electors at the reading room of the Fishermen and Seamen's Home, 347 Duckworth Street, within the said Town of St. John's, on **FRIDAY the SEVENTEENTH DAY** of the month of June, from 10 a.m. until 2 of the clock in the afternoon, for the purpose of nominating persons to represent them as Mayor and Councillors in the St. John's Municipal Council, and that in case a Poll be demanded and allowed in the manner by Law prescribed, such Poll will be opened on Monday, the 27th day of the month of June, in the year 1910, from the hour of Eight of the clock in the morning until Eight of the clock in the evening in each of the Polling Divisions to be hereafter fixed by Proclamation of His Excellency the Governor.

And further that at the Reading Room of the Fishermen and Seamen's Home, I shall open the Ballot Boxes, count the votes given for the several candidates, and return as elected to the representative offices those having the majority of votes; of which all persons are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

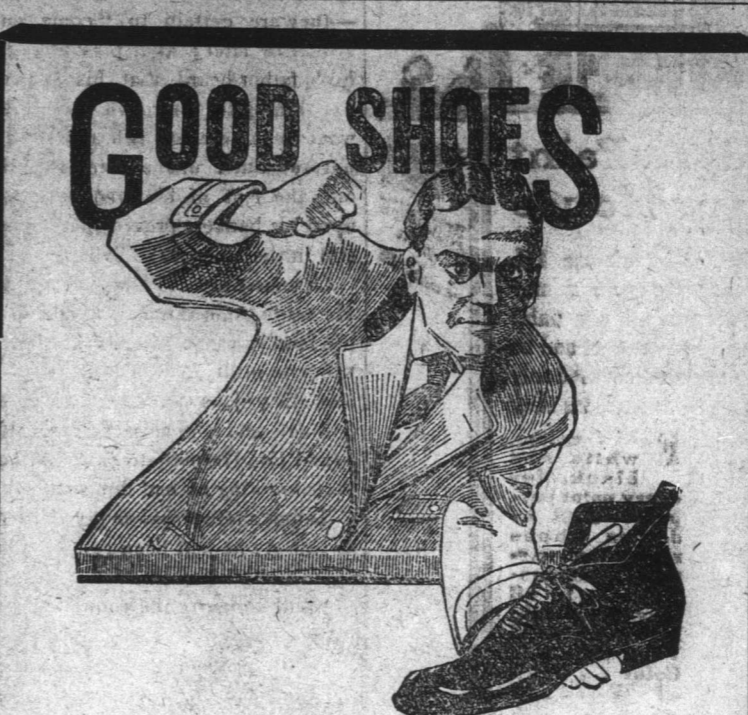
