**CALGARY
 IN BRIEF**
 Mr. Harold B. Jacobson has returned
 to California after spending the winter
 in California and the Southern States.

 The city planning commission fore-
 gathered yesterday noon at the Crown's
 Bathhouse, where the luncheon was
 served. It was announced that C. H.

 represent this city at the convention of
 town planners which is being held in
 Chicago shortly. It is possible that
 Alderman Garden will also be present.
 Fifteen horses, one cow, one colt,

**LIBERALS WILL GET
 EVERYTHING EAST
 OF EDMONTON**
 Three-Cornered Fight in
 Victoria, but Liberal Will Prob-
 ably Win Out
**LIBERAL CONVENTION
 BEING HELD TODAY**
 Hon. A. G. McKay Made Good
 in Address at Edmonton
 on Monday
 Edmonton, Alta., April 8.—Four
 Liberal meetings were held in
 various parts of the city. Hon. A. G.
 McKay was not present, as he is
 assisting Liberal candidates in other
 parts of the province, but Senator
 Candidate C. W. Cross and other promi-
 nent Liberals were heard. Mr. Mac-
 Kay's great speech on Monday night
 at the monster Liberal rally was one
 of the ablest masterpieces ever de-
 livered. He claimed that it won him hundreds
 of votes among people whom he had not
 been known to before.
 Mr. A. Bramley Moore, late repre-
 sentative for Laydminster, who is
 not a candidate in the present elec-
 tion, but who is taking very lively interest
 in the campaign nevertheless, returned
 from the eastern boundary of the pro-
 vince today, after having been through
 Wainwright and Battle River constituencies.
 Mr. Moore declares that while
 there is a genuine fight going in that
 part of the province there is no doubt
 that the government candidates will
 carry every seat east of the city. He
 left for St. Paul to take a train to
 that constituency in a car of P. B.
 Leasard.
 Hon. J. R. Boyle is campaigning in
 the Pembina district and other out-
 lying points. Last night he spoke at
 Clyde on behalf of Gordon McDonald,
 the Liberal candidate for Pembina,
 where he received a great reception.
 James H. Wood, Mayor of Atha-
 busca Landing, was nominated at a
 Conservative convention last night to
 contest the riding at the forthcoming
 general election. The selection was
 quite unanimous.
Three-Cornered Fight in Victoria
 A nomination, which is in the na-
 ture of a forlorn hope, was made at
 Lacombe yesterday when R. A. Ben-
 nett, Canadian Northern agent in that
 town, was placed in the field by the
 Conservatives to contest Victoria, rid-
 ing against Frank A. Walker, M.P.
 This makes it a three-cornered
 fight in that constituency, but the Con-
 servative candidates will get practically
 no support and is almost certain to
 lose his deposit, while Michael Gowd,
 who is running as an independent, is
 dependent for his support upon the
 nationality Walker's re-election is
 said by his friends to be a certainty.
 The Liberal convention for the dis-
 trict of St. Paul will probably be the
 last of the present campaign. It
 will be held in St. Paul at 4
 P. M. tomorrow afternoon, at
 which it is expected that representa-
 tives of every polling subdivision in
 riding will be represented. Nomeni-
 ation will in all probability be by
 ballot. P. B. Leasard, although
 Lawrence Government, former of Atha-
 busca Landing, is a likely runner.
 The Conservative opposition in the
 riding is not particularly strong, but
 gets the Liberal nomination is prac-
 tically certain of election. Leasard has
 been in the country keeping the
