View Near Amherstburg, Showing Limestone Sought By Solvay Process Company



LIBERAL CANDIDATE IN SOUTH HURON



Solray Process Company, Manufacturing Soda Ash and Kindred Commodities, Securi ng Options on Land at High Valuations.

[Special to The Advertiser.]
AMHERSTBURG, May 20.—An immense industry is coming to Amherstburg, and this announcement partly solves the real estate boom that has for the past few months been agitating the farm-owners just outside the boundary of the town and along the Detroit River for seven miles north.

The Solvay Process Company, a world-wide concern, is coming in here with a plant for the manufacture of soda ash and kindred commodities. It is for this company that options have been taken on farms aggregating hundreds of acres, and on account of the operations of their agents, land values have soared.

It has come to such a pass that it is impossible to get a foot of land between here and Windsor, twenty miles, for less than \$200

The latest transaction reported is that of a 70-acre farm, seven miles north of here, optioned by the company for \$40,000; that is

It is the splendid quality of limestone rock and the prospect of securing a plentiful supply of salt that has brought the concern into this district. Salt is essential to the manufacture of soda ash. Three Plants in States.

The company is largely comprised of English capitalists and has large plants in Syracuse, Detroit and Kansas City in the United States, in Belgium and England, in Europe, and in Australia and Africa. Soda ash and the 40 or so bye-products are used for innumerable purposes in the manufacture of soap, in softening water for railway locomotives, in making bleaching powders, washing soda, caustic soda, in the manufacture of glass.

Part of the great areas of land leased has been for storing salt, part for the limestone and part for a site for the manufacturing

Those representing the company are very reticent and have been pursuing their operations secretly.

The company had English experts here last fall looking over the district and making tests, and it has been on the strength of their reports that the countryside along the river has been blank-

eted with options. The Detroit plant cost \$4,000,000 and employs over 200 hands, and it is probable that the Amherstburg plant will attain to equal or larger proportions.
