The following are the names of the places where there are settlers: the river aux Canards, Point à Bouleau, Anse St. Jean, River Ste Marguerite, Moulin Baude, the Bergeronnes, Bon Désir, and Escoumains.

Might there not be given to these Indians a certain part of the revenues accruing from the sale of the lands and the cutting of timber?

There are ten or twelve Montagnais established in the Bay of *Milles Vaches*. They petition to have their lands preserved to them without payment of the legal dues.

Mr. George Duberger wished that there should be reserved for the Montagnais the land situate between the River Manikuagan and the River des Outardes, but it is in no wise fit for agriculture.
