

BROILED SALT MACKEREL. -Select a small macketel (which will be more tender than a large, older one) and put it to soak over night in plenty of cold water; pour off the water and let it stand in milk two hours; then drain and dry in a napkin, brush butter, or better still, pure olive oil over it, and and broil in a double-wire broiler; when done plunge it into hot water a moment, which swells it and makes it look fat; serve with melted butter con-taining lemon juice and chopped pars-

OYSTER SALAD. —Bring to a boil a dozen and a half of oysters in their dozen and a half of oysters in their own liquor, to which two tablespoons-ful of good strong vinegar have been added, with white and red pepper and salt for seasoning; drain, and cut the oysters in dice so as not to injure their sppearance. Wash a head of celery and cut the edible parts in dice; mix with the oysters, and keep in a very cold place until ready to serve, when cold place until ready to serve, when cover with a mayonnaise or salad dres-

SCALUPED OYSTERS.—One quart of large selected oysters, one dozen of crackere, one egg and nearly a cupful of butter; seasoning. With a fork dip each oyster in the slightly beaten egg, and then in the cracker crumbs which have previously been rolled fine, and place in a buttered dish. Add neaner. place in a buttered dish.
