Revival of healthy public interest touched nearly all stocks to-day and strengthed nearly all stocks to-day and strength-ened nearly all, making them active, ad-vancing the values in general. The mar-ket had strong working business of me-dium volume. The outstanding character-istic this session was the strength of Re-public. At 109 it closed 2½ points high-er than on Saturday. It secured, however, 111 as the highest price, while the largest parcel of shares changed acrids at 110.
