HELP FOR IRELAND. To the Editor of THE TRUE WITNESS: Sir,—I have noticed with satisfaction the howl of rage that arises from certain classes beyond the waters of the Atlantic, to help Irish tenants to defend themselves against extortionate and rapacious landlords. The governing classes of England desire to starve, evict, and immigrate all the old race out of Ireland, and they would have nearly succeeded by this time if God in His mercy had not inspired men in America had not assisted them. But if landlordism has been checked a little, it would be a great mistake to imagine that it is crushed or that it is not our duty to redouble our efforts and prepare to meet the final struggle, which cannot be much longer delayed. With this end in view, I would respectfully enquire of the gentlemen who take an active part in the affairs of the League if it would not be advisable to adopt additional methods in order to make contributions still more general than at present. While delighted with the spectacle of zeal and self-sacrifice so generally displayed, yet I know places in the United States and Canada where contributions of fifty cents and upwards might be published in the nearest Irish newspaper, and smaller sums might be published in lump over the signatures of the committee or collectors. All this would, no doubt, entail a great deal of labor; but, on the other hand, it would give the scattered Irish a chance to subscribe to the cause, and increase the number of workers, and materially assist the common cause. No man need be ashamed of the smallness of the sum which his want of means restricts him to, but any Irishman ought to be ashamed of never contributing anything to redeem the land of Ireland. MR. O'BRIEN'S RETURN TO DUBLIN A MAGNIFICENT Ovation—GRANDS FOR LORD LANDSDOWNE. DUBLIN, June 19.—William O'Brien arrived here this evening and was received with the greatest ovation witnessed here in many years. He was met at the railway station by the Lord Mayor and corporation, and by Messrs. Davitt, Kenney and others. Mr. O'Brien entered the Lord Mayor's carriage, which was then dragged along by a crowd of citizens, the horses having been detached. A procession into the city, composed of thousands of citizens, with banners, and a deputations of the Gaelic Athletic Society, comprising hundreds of members all dressed in costume, joined the procession. The route of the procession, extending two miles, was densely packed with people, and all the windows along the line were crowded with people. The Lord Mayor, from the balcony on Sackville street, proposed cheers for O'Brien, Davitt, the Bolyke tenants and Gladstone, and groans for Lord Lansdowne, all racking renting landlords and Salisbury. The responses were lusty. Mr. O'Brien spoke briefly, his voice falling to reach more than a small part of the assemblage. The crush of people was enormous, many persons fainting.
