Yet Italy Will Defend Her African Interests to the Last.

Rome, November 25.—The Italian Parliament was opened to-day by King Humbert. In his speech from the throne His Majesty alluded to the smallness of the deficit in the budget and said the government's wise and equitable policy assured tranquility to Italy.

The King was enthusiastically cheered on his way to and from the parliament. King Humbert announced that bills for reforming charitable institutions, providing for establishing primary schools and for protecting workingmen against accidents would be introduced in Parliament.
