

The New Minister of Public Works

The Hon. William Pugsley resigned the Premiership of New Brunswick to enter the Federal arena. He has been a member of the Bar for thirty-five years. He entered the Legislature in 1885 and four years later became Solicitor-General. On the death of Lieutenant-Governor Snowball, who was succeeded by Premier Tweedie some months ago, Mr. Pugsley was called on to form a ministry.
