The Department of External Affairs wishes to remind Canadian citizens who may have lost property, situated in Italy, as a result of the war that in order not to risk forfeiture of their rights under the Treaty of Peace with Italy, a demand for restoration of such property must be made before September 15, 1948, to the Government of Italy.

The Department of External Affairs has been advised that such demand may be made directly to Ufficio Beni Alleati e Nemici, Ministero del Tesoro, Rome, Italy.
