Members of the Permanent Court of Arbitration hold office for six years and serve without honorarium. They represent the Bench, the academic community, the public service and the practising bar.

In addition to duties as arbitrators which they may be called on to perform, the Canadian Members also serve as the Canadian National Group for the International Court of Justice.
