DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Mark MacGuigan, announces the following appointment:

David M. Miller (50) born in Kashmir, to be High Commissioner to Kenya, and concurrently accredited to Uganda; Permanent Representative to the United Nations Environment Programme and to the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements.

Mr. Miller (B. Comm., LL.B., University of British Columbia) joined the Department of External Affairs in 1959. He served abroad in Pretoria (1961-65); London (1969-1971); and Bonn (1976-79). He has also served as Director of Legal Operations Division in Ottawa (1971-76). In 1979 he became Director-General of Personnel and in January of this year Assistant Under-Secretary for International Activities. He replaces Geoffrey F. Bruce who has returned to Canada.
