- (3) The Advisory Board on the Co-ordination of Rehabilitation Services for Disabled Persons shall consider and report to the Council on any matter within the Minister's responsibilities in relation to the co-ordination of rehabilitation services for disabled persons in Canada. 5
- Advisory Board on Manpower and Immigration Research 10
- (4) The Advisory Board on Manpower and Immigration Research shall consider and report to the Council on any matter within the Minister's responsibilities in relation to manpower and immigration research in Canada. 10
- Duties of boards
- (5) Any advisory board established by the Minister under this Part shall consider and report to the Council on
- (a) all matters within the terms of reference of the board as established by the Minister; and 15
- (b) any further matters referred to the board by the Council.

PART III

REGIONAL AND LOCAL MANPOWER COMMITTEES

- Regional and local manpower committees 20
- 21.** (1) The Minister may establish such regional and local manpower committees as he considers necessary for the purpose of advising and assisting the Department in carrying out the functions of its manpower service. 20
- Appointment of members
- (2) Regional and local manpower committees established under subsection (1) shall include members chosen after consultation with such representative organizations as the Minister deems appropriate. 25
- Remuneration and allowances
- (3) Each member of a committee established under subsection (1) shall be paid such remuneration and travelling allowances in connection with the work of his committee as are approved by the Treasury Board.

PART IV

GENERAL

- 22.** The Minister may provide the Council, or any board established under this Act, or any regional or local manpower committee, with such professional, technical, secretarial and other assistance as they may require, but the provision of such assistance otherwise than from the public service of Canada is subject to approval by the Treasury Board. 30 35
