At the meeting of the Board of Governors of McGill University held yesterday morning, I put before them the matter of pension for Mrs. Leach, the widow of the late Rev. Leach, at one time Vice Principal of the University. The Board authorized an appropriation of \$600 per annum, the amount to be paid in monthly instalments of \$50.00 each, beginning first of August next.
