Re L.D. Crestohl.

Referring to the enclosed clipping which you sent to me some days ago, I have interviewed Mr. Crestohl and find that the charge referred to arose out of the disorder which occurred in a polling booth in the St. Lawrence Ward during the recent provincial elections. Mr. Crestohl was one of the scrutineers of this booth, and the person who really started the trouble pointed him out subsequently to a policeman as one of those who had been concerned in the assault. According to Mr. Crestohl the charge was quite unfounded, and this is borne out by the fact that when the case came to trial the complainant withdrew the charge.

Mr. Crestohl published an explanation of the whole matter in the "Jewish Chronicle", which he has shown me, but I think we may consider the question closed so far as the University is concerned.
