Dear Mr. Maher,

You may be aware that during the last few years an Institute of Parasitology has been established at Macdonald College by the Research Council, the Government of the Province of Quebec and this University. The work of the Institute consists in the examination of very numerous parasites existing throughout Canada and causing very large losses among animals and livestock of all kinds, as well as attacking human beings.

One of the districts which suffers particularly is the Arctic area. Last year an officer of the Institute visited the Eastern Arctic and a great deal of material brought back by him or sent in to us afterwards has now been examined. The Director wishes to get a report out at once. A written report can only be sent by the Mascopie, but the Director has prepared a radio report which could be given in a very few minutes. Owing to the extreme importance of the matter in question to the people of the Arctic, we should be grateful if you would arrange to have this message sent out in as efficient a manner as possible.
