## RULES OF THE ASSOCIATION.

1. What are the indispensable conditions of membership in the Association of the Holy Family?

a. To be enrolled in the Association by giving the name of the flead of the family to the pastor of the Congregation.

b. To have a picture of the Holy Family in one's house.

c. To say daily some prayer before that picture.

2. Must the prayer of consecration be said every

day?

The prayer "O most loving Jesus"; etc. (page 20), is designed by the Holy Father to be said every day. Nevertheless its omission does not deprive of membership.

3. May the prayers of the Association be said publicly in the church?

Yes, if they are approved by the Ordinary and said before a picture of the Holy. Family.

4. Do the rules of the Association of the Holy Family bind under pain of mortal sin?

No, but the neglect of their observance deprives of the indulgences to be gained by observing them.

5. May the inmates of seminaries and colleges, and the members of religious communities be enrolled?

Yes, it was so decided by the S. C. of Rites, February 13, 1892.
