

And also, we do, by these presents, ratify and confirm unto the said council, and their successors, all privileges, franchises, liberties, and immunities, granted in our said former letters patents, and not in these our letters patents, revoked, altered, changed, or abridged, although expressed, mention, &c.—In witness, &c. witness ourself at Westminster, the third day of November, in the eighteenth year of our reign over England, &c.
