Constitution and the By-laws of the Lodge.

- Clause 3—To hold regular and special meetings as provided by the By-Laws.
- Clause 4—To fix and establish Initiation
  Fees, providing they be not less than Five
  Dollars (\$5.00) for Sisters and Brothers,
  and Dues to be paid monthly, quarterly, semi-annually, or annually, as the
  By-laws may provide; and to provide by
  By-Laws, when those in arrears for dues
  for one year may be suspended for nonepayment thereof.
- Clause 5—To pay and disburse from the funds of the Lodge, from time to time, as a mapority of the members present shall by vote determine, for any of the declared purposes of this Degree as set forth in Article II.
- Clause 6.—To establish such By-laws and Rules of Order, not inconsistent herewith, or with the rules, usages and general regulations of the Order, as it may deem proper; subject, however, to the approval of the Rebekah Assembly of British Columbia.
- Clause 7.—To grant Withdrawal Cards to members who are clear of the books, and
