Henry H. Howe, an aged actor, who came to America with Henry Irving, was found dead in his apartments at the Burnet House, Cincinnati, Tuesday night. He was 84 years old. Cause of death, pneumonia. His real name was Henry Howe Hutchinson, and he was born in Norwich, England. The late Thomas Sloane of New York left a large fortune to his wife, with a proviso that if she marrried again she would forfeit \$200,000.
