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the powers of the Provincial Synod, and the jurisdiction and powers of any Courts established under the authority thereof, presented a report from the said Committee, which, on motion, was ordered to be received. (*See Appendix*).

Moved by Mr. Hurd Peters, seconded by Mr. S. Foster,

That the consideration of the Report of the Committee on union with the Provincial Synod, be taken up at the next meeting of the Synod,

And on the question being taken, it was decided in the negative.

Moved by Mr. W. M. Jarvis, seconded by the Rev. Canon

That this Synod, being the Synod of the Church of

England in the Diocese of Fredericton and Province of New

Brunswick, constituted in conformity with the provisions of an

Act of the Legislature of the late Province of Canada, passed in

session thereof held in the nineteenth and twentieth years of

present Majesty's reign, chaptered one hundred and forty-one,

intituled 'An Act to enable the members of the United Church

of England and Ireland, in Canada, to meet in Synod;' and by

the Rectory of an Act of the Legislature of the Province of New

Brunswick, passed in the thirty-fourth year of the reign of her

Majesty, intituled 'An Act relating to the Synod of the

Church of England in the Diocese of Fredericton and Province

of New Brunswick;' and consisting of the Bishop, clergy and

members of the Church of England in the Diocese of Fre-

dericton and Province of New Brunswick, DOTH HEREBY ADOPT

said Act of the late Province of Canada, nineteenth and

twentieth Victoria, chapter one hundred and forty-one, and DOTH

with the members of the said Church in other Provinces

of Canada in the General Assembly or Synod, known as the

General Synod of Canada, subject to the provisions of an Act

of the Legislature of the Dominion of Canada, passed in the

fourth year of her said Majesty's reign, intituled 'An Act

to amend the Province of New Brunswick the operation of the

Legislature of the late Province of Canada, concern-

ing the Synod of the Church of England in Canada.' "

The question having been debated, on motion, the Synod

was adjourned until Thursday, July 4th, at half-past nine o'clock
