IBANEZ WILL FIGHT AGAINST ALFONSO

Famous Poet Declares Spain Must Be Freed From Military Dictatorship.

WILL MAKE NOISE

Will Publish to World the Story of Conditions in His Country.

EDITOR'S NOTE:—Vicente Ibanez, the world-famous Spanish author, has announced that he will devote the rest of his life to fighting the military dictatorship of Primo de Rivera, and that Spain may be rescued from what he says is a tyrannical rule by becoming a republic in the following year. Ibanez, who has written extensively for the United States, has been in Canada for some time, and is now in St. John, N. B.

Paris, Oct. 14.—The hour has struck. I can no longer remain silent about what is happening in Spain. My people are in captivity. I will devote the rest of my life to fighting King Alfonso and the military dictatorship. I have been silent too long. My conscience will not allow me to rest until I bring succor to my motherland. For a long time I have been preparing to expose and attack conditions in Spain, and now I hope to publish them throughout the world and strike a ringing blow at tyranny. As long as King Alfonso stays in Spain I shall fight him. I will do everything possible to topple him from the throne.

This is no sudden decision. I have thought long and hard. I couldn't sleep at night. My conscience kept saying to me "What right have you to live like a prince, in your wonderful house, beside the Mediterranean, at Mentone, with your automobiles, and luxuries? What right have you to live luxuriously and comfortably when your country is suffering? You must abandon all this, and go out and fight."

My friends demand to know what right I, as one of the most widely known Spaniards, who am able to speak to millions throughout the world, have to keep silent. I am going to speak. It will make a noise in the world. Remember, I am to get nothing for it. I refused great sums for the purchase of Spain. I am going to give to the press of the world. I will lose greatly more than people will realize, but the die is cast. Spain has submitted too long to pillage, tyranny, and there must be an end to this new era of inquisition. To accomplish that, we must strike at its head. Those in greatest position, are the guilty.

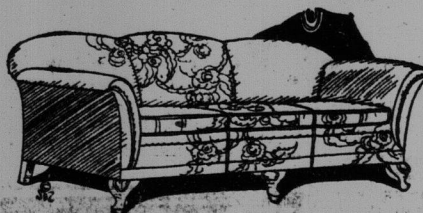

ASKS BIGGER AIR BUDGET

Secretary Weeks Seeks \$10,000,000 More for New Equipment.

Washington, Oct. 14.—The War Department in its budget estimates has asked for \$28,000,000 more than last year, Secretary Weeks announced recently. The estimate does not include the pay of personnel. Mr. Weeks explained that it was planned to spend from \$10,000,000 to \$12,000,000 for new equipment.

The \$28,000,000 includes both the primary budget estimates, which cover what it absolutely needed, and supplementary estimates, which represent what is desirable but which embrace projects that may be postponed.

The feeling on the part of the War Department, and particularly of the Air Service, is that much of the equipment is out of date and is kept in flying condition only at great expense and with risk to the personnel.

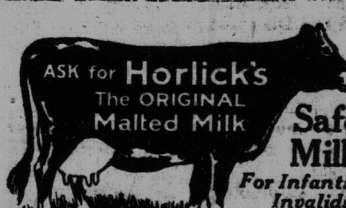

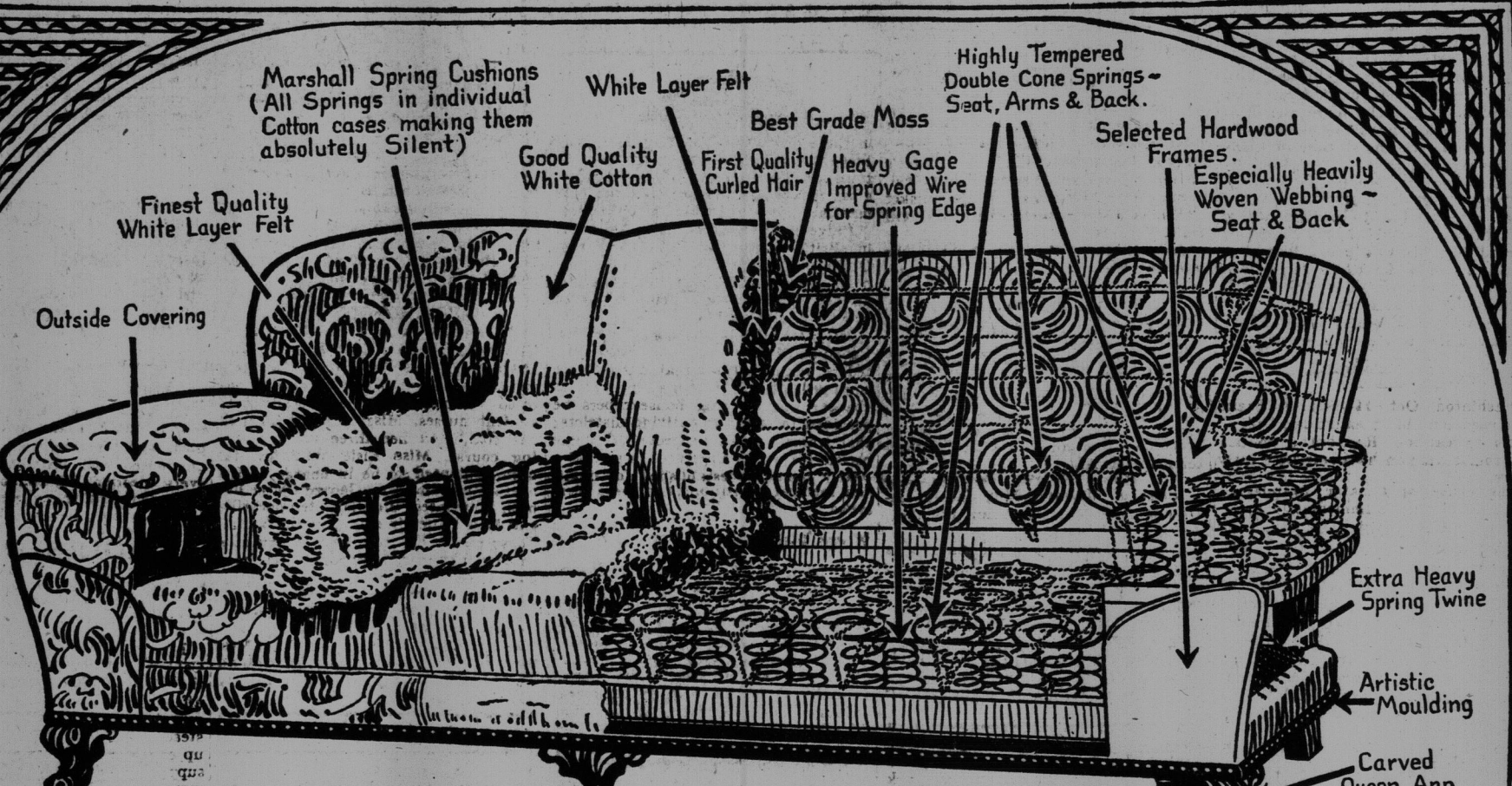

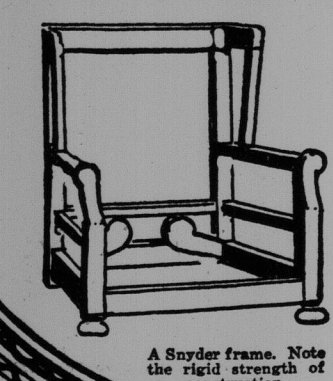
