#### CLOSE PUBLIC HOUSES AT 10 P. M.

Appeals for Early and Late in Kensington Hall, London.

London, Nov. 2.—(Canadian Press Cable).—The Kensington town hall was crowded today when the licensing justices met to fix the hour for closing public houses.

A number of religious bodies had deputations present to urge an early closing time. Their spokesmen said that they had recently visited thirty-two Kensington public houses on an evening and had found thirty-two of them open at 10 p. m.

The justices decided on ten o'clock. A representative of "Fellowship, Freedom and Reform" said he had drunk beer since he was two years old and he demanded that eleven o'clock be closing time, "in the name of four million English people."

An attempt by the religious deputations to sing the Doxology was suppressed.
