HOW CUB REPORTER SCOOPED MELVILLE STONE Charles Chapin Tells How He "Put It Over" Veteran in Old Chicago Days.

One of the few men who successfully "scooped" Melville E. Stone, now general manager of the Associated Press, is at present serving a life sentence in Sing Sing prison. He is Charles E. Chapin, formerly city editor of the New York Evening World, whose extraordinary book describing his life, career, and the tragic events which terminated it, has just been published by Putnams under the title of "Charles Chapin's Story."

Chapin was a cub reporter on the Chicago Tribune when Stone was one of the star men on the Daily News. McGarrigle, the former chief of police, was collector of boodle for the corrupt political ring which then largely ruled affairs in Chicago. The newspapers finally forced a grand jury investigation, following which several county commissioners fled the country, and some others together with McGarrigle were jailed, convicted and sentenced to long terms.

Before he was sent to Joliet penitentiary McGarrigle contrived to escape on the schooner Blake through the Great Lakes. Then it was that Stone for the Daily News and Chapin for the Tribune started in pursuit.
