 Nicholas Indian Chief, Maraw Nicholas, Peter  
 Nicholas, Joseph Jerome, Peter Jerome, Thomas Jerome  
 John Nicholas and Michael McIntosh, all belonging  
 to the Tribe of New Mac Indians residing in Barbours  
 in the County of Kent and Province of New Brunswick  
 For and in consideration of the sum of twenty  
 five pounds current money of the Province aforesaid  
 to us in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 into and truly paid by Peter Allain Junior of Barbours  
 aforesaid, have granted bargained and sold  
 and by these presents do grant bargain and sell  
 unto the said Peter Allain Junior one certain  
 piece of land situated in the Indian Reserve on  
 the North side of the Big Barouché River in the Parish  
 of Wellington, and bounded as follows upon the South  
 by the road leading to the Ship Yard and a certain  
 tract of land granted by the present grantors to one  
 Samuel Allain upon the East by a part of the  
 said Indian Reserve before the West by a line now  
 in the possession of Nehemiah Beckwith, and upon  
 the North by the East line of the Indian Reserve to  
 measure in length upon a straight line between  
 the East and West the same number of chains  
 and links as is granted to Samuel Allain and  
 no more, and to contain in the whole seventy acres
