Prov. Club by certificate from the Club to which he belongs, or by a voucher from his club.

ARTICLE III.

The time and locality of all regular meetiof this club shall be determined at the and meeting, but the Prov. S O shall be authori to meet any exigency that may arice. ARTICLE IV.

When any member of Prov. C shall violate his pledge, the secretary of subordinate club to which he belongs s immediately notify the Prov. Club.

When the Prov. Sec. is intern Sec. -2. that any brother has violated his pledocia in drawn from the order, or ceared sol, no member of subordinate club from cause, he shall erase the name of the broth from the roll of Prov. Club, and notice on same in his annual report.

Sec. 3. If there be an appeal entered against the decision of any subordinate club in expelling a member of Prov. Club, the Prov. Sec. shall not erase his name from Prov. roll

till said appearis decided.

When a subordinate club to which Sec. 4 any officer of Prov. Club belongs ceases to exist, he shall retain his seat in Prov. Club until the expiration of his term of office.

ARTICLE V. No amendment shall be made in these Bye Laws except at the annual meeting.
