COAL COMMISSION REPORT

Recommends General Increase of Wages Amounting to Ten Per Cent.—Settlement of all Difficulties by Arbitration—Cannot Discriminate.

Washington, March 21.—The Anthracite Coal Commission's report recommends a general increase of wages amounting in most instances to ten per cent. and in some to a decrease in time, the settlement of all disputes by arbitration. It also fixes the minimum wage and sliding scale, provides against discrimination by either mine owners or miners on account of membership or non-membership in labor unions, and provides that the awards made shall continue in force until March 31, 1906.
