The Picnic Lunch

A sandwich which is a little more trouble, but which quite repays for the effort to make it, is made by chopping English walnuts and mixing with cream cheese and a little chopped watercress finishing with a little mayonnaise. Add a spray of cress after the mixture is spread on the bread.

At a picnic given last summer one of the girls brought thin rolls, not over two inches in diameter and made quite round in shape. The tops of each roll had been cut to form a lid, the crumbs pulled out and the cavity filled with chopped chicken seasoned with salt and black pepper, and made moist with very thick cream.

Every one has a favorite recipe for deviled eggs, and the usual one is to mash the yolks of hard boiled eggs, add mustard, salt and pepper to taste, with enough vinegar to make the mixture moist, and finally a little chopped meat. When well mixed, it is molded into balls and returned to the cavity in the whites of the eggs. A good variation of this is to add grated cheese instead of meat, and mayonnaise or cream salad dressing instead of vinegar.
