
BILL.

An Act to repeal a certain provision of the Act for the disposal of Public Lands, relative to the period within which indemnity may be granted for errors in Patents.

BE it enacted, &c.

That the proviso to the twenty-eighth section of the Act passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled "*An Act for the*
 5 "*disposal of Public Lands,*" which is in the words following: "And provided also, that no such claim for indemnity shall be entertained after the space of five years from the issue of the Letters Patent granting or conceding such lot or parcel of land, or shall extend to cover the value
 10 of any improvements made by the grantees in error or mistake, under any such grant," shall be and is hereby repealed.

Proviso to Sect. 28, of 4 & 5 Vict. c. 100, repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That no such claim shall be en-
 15 tertained after five years from the passing of this Act, nor unless the whole of the land intended to have been granted shall be found wanting, or to have been previously granted to some other person.
