then, and in any or either of the Cases aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for the Bishop of Quebec for the Timebeing, on behalf of the said Protestant Clergy, in compliance with any Requisition in Writing to him for that Purpose made by such Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or other Person administering the Government of the said Province, and he is hereby required, by a Deed under his Hand and Seal, duly attested by Two or more credible Witnesses, to surrender, yield up, and convey to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, the Lands comprized and described in any such Requisition as aforesaid, in Exchange for other Lands situate in the said Province, of equal Extent and Value. to be by His Majesty appropriated and set apart for the Support and Maintenance of Protestant Clergy therein; and which Deed, so executed by the said Bishop of Quebec for the Time being, shall be valid and effectual in Law, to vest in his Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, all the Lands therein included and comprized; and such Lands shall and may, by His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, be re-granted and re-conveyed to any other Person or Persons, for quieting their Possession and Titles, or otherwise, as may from Time to Time be expedient or necessary, without any further Appropriation of Land being thereupon made for the Benefit of a Protestant Clergy.
