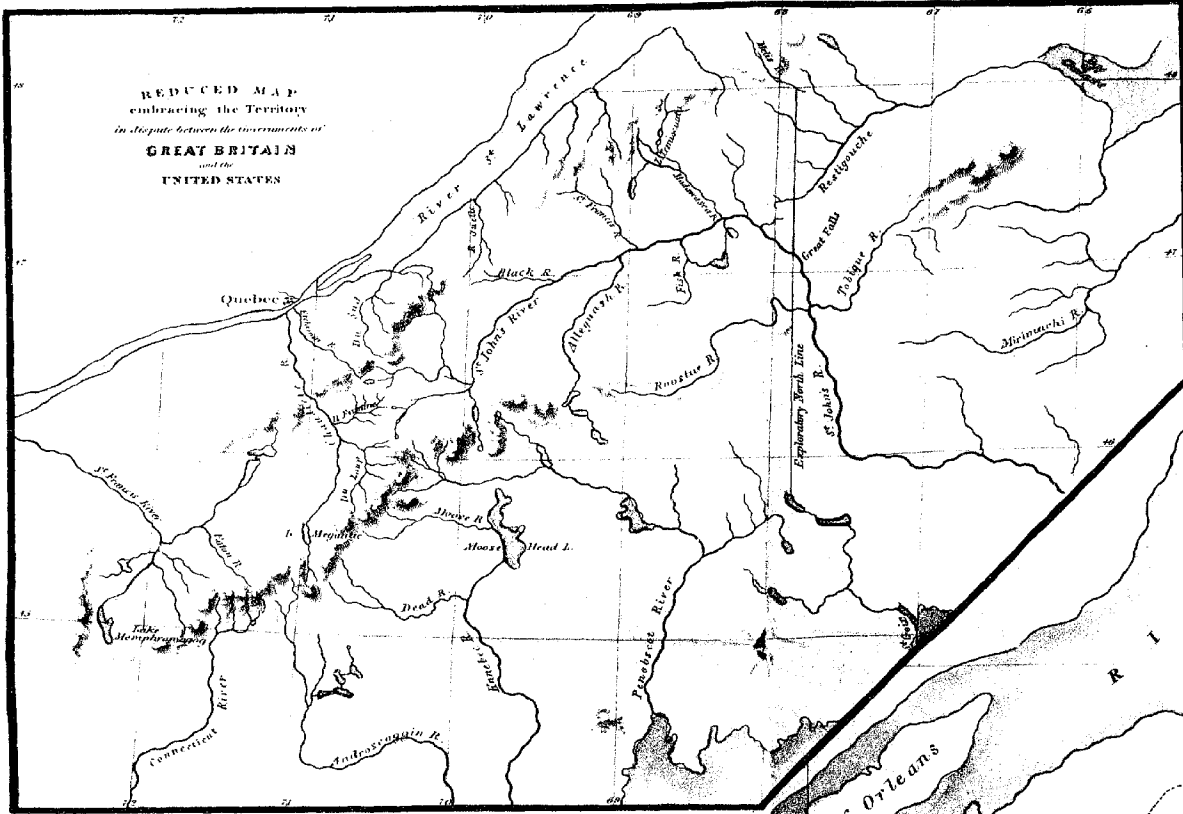
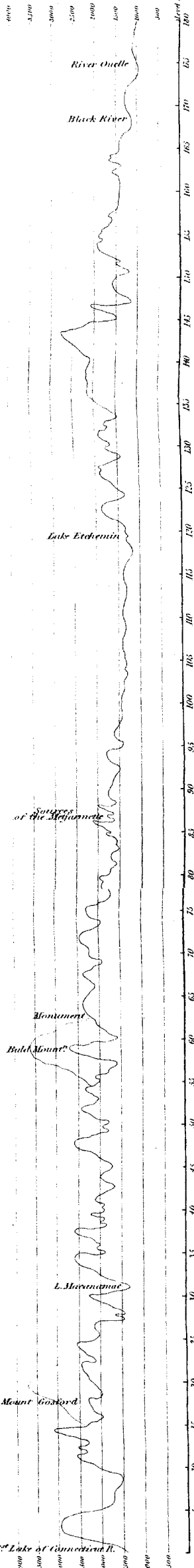


Section cut from Lake Umbagog to the River Ouelle along the division of Waters claimed by the United States as the line of Boundary
