Remarks:

Alsike constitutes our major seed crop. Production of red clover is increasing rapidly. By virtue of being northern grown, our clovers are believed to possess special qualities of hardiness and freedom from impurities. Clover seed production should be maintained as an important industry.

Recommendation: Continuation of present tariff.
