Sir,

With reference to my circular of even number, dated 22nd May, 1886, in which I invited a renewal of your attention to my circular of the 31st December, 1885, re vaccination and health of the Indians in your charge and requested you to report as fully as possible upon the subject matter thereof; I have to point out that, although the general sanitary precautions alluded to in section 6 of that circular are hardly secondary in importance to the clauses relating to vaccination, yet the latter alone have been reported on.

I have, therefore, to request that you will inform me fully as to what steps you have taken to comply with the requirements of section 6, referred to.
