I am M-38326 L cpl SAVER, J.H., NQ RCE 2 Cdn Inf Div. I last saw B-113934 Spr LYTTLE, J.J. on the 29 April 45, the day before he left on leave to England. I have not seen him since that time in unit lines until he arrived at this HQ at 1200 hrs 29 Jul 45 under escort. I was then told by Lt CARLTON to hold Spr LYTTLE under close arrest, which I have done.
