Re: License # 266, I.R. 13

Under special conditions, Paragraph 4, this paragraph should have read:

"Wood fuel to be made available to the Indians at the mill."

We have no facilities for delivering wood fuel, and if we were obliged to hire a truck at \$28.00 per day this cost would be prohibitive in this small operation of a portable mill. We did not notice this dondition in the contract at the time of renewal and herewith apply to have Paragraph 4 changed to the above wording.
